



Ottawa Ice Breaker Tournament – Code of Conduct

This code of conduct applies to: Players, Parents, Coaches, Team Officials, Referees, Spectators, and Tournament Staff

General Principles

Show respect for all participants, including opponents, teammates, officials, volunteers, and tournament organizers.

Promote a positive, inclusive, and supportive environment.

Demonstrate good sportsmanship in all interactions and decisions.

Facilities

Respect all facility protocols.

Please remove all water bottles and garbage and place them in proper receptacles.

Hillcrest HS and Franco Cite Turf Fields

No dogs are permitted inside OISC turf fields.

No food is permitted inside turf fields.

No gum is permitted inside turf fields.

All chairs, benches and canopies are not permitted on the turf. They must be on the asphalt around the turf fields and not within the safety zone outside the turf field.

Remove all refuse when you depart and place in an appropriate receptacle.

Players

Compete with integrity and within the rules of the game.

Accept all referee decisions respectfully.

Avoid engaging in verbal or physical altercations with others.

Coaches and Team Officials

Lead by example in promoting sportsmanship and ethical behavior.

Communicate respectfully with referees and tournament staff.

Ensure all players understand and follow the Code of Conduct.

Parents and Spectators

Cheer positively and respectfully for all players.

Refrain from coaching from the sidelines.

Do not question referee decisions or direct negative comments at players, officials, or other spectators.

Referees

Officiate matches fairly, safely, and in accordance with Ontario Soccer standards.

Communicate clearly and respectfully with players and team officials.

Report all incidents of misconduct promptly and accurately to a Field Marshal or Competition Coordinator.

Tournament Officials

Treat all participants with impartiality and respect.

Enforce tournament rules and this Code of Conduct consistently.

Promote a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for all.

Breaches of Conduct

Violations of this Code of Conduct may result in:

Verbal or written warnings

Removal from the game site

Suspension or expulsion from the tournament

Reporting to the participant's Club, District Association, or Ontario Soccer for further action

Respect the Game. Respect your Opponents. Respect the Officials. Respect the Volunteers.
