



Ottawa Ice Breaker Tournament Rules Summary

Rule Area	Details
Girls Tournament	May 24–25, 2025
Boys Tournament	May 31–June 1, 2025
Age Groups	U13 (2012), U14 (2011), U15 (2010), U16 (2009), U17/U18 (2007,2008)
Gender Policy	Play in division aligned with registered gender designation
Player Documentation	TRR/Player cards or passports, official OS roster, proof of insurance, travel permits if needed
Game Guarantee	Minimum 3 games
Divisions	Tier 1: Ice; Tier 2: Snow; or Open Seeding Divisions
Point System	3 pts win, 2 pts shootout win, 1 pt shootout loss, 0 pts regulation loss
Shootouts	Prelim: 3 shooters; Semis/Finals: 5 shooters
Tiebreakers	Head-to-head → Wins → GF → GA → Shutouts → Coin toss or penalties
Ball Size	Size 5 (FIFA approved)
Game Duration	40 minutes + 5-minute half
Minimum and Maximum Roster Size	Minimum number of players to register for the tournament is 16 and the maximum number of players is 20. Teams must have a minimum of 7 players on the field at all times.
Substitutions	Unlimited; as per FIFA, only on own throw-in unless both teams substitute
Guest Players	Max 6; no more than 3 from outside club; must have OS permit
Game Sheets	Given to referee by Field Marshal; ID checks 10 mins prior if requested
Referee Reports	Ref completes OS caution/dismissal forms and SIRs, submits to Marshal
Conduct	All are responsible for conduct; red card = 1 game suspension
Protests	\$200 deposit; only non-referee judgment calls; must be within 20 mins
Minimum Players	7 players to start/continue; default = 2-0 loss
Weather	Delay/relocate; 75% = complete; shootout/coin toss if needed
Check-In	Local: Thursday prior; Travelling: 60 mins before 1st match at competition centre.
Authority	FIOC oversees rules and enforcement; no appeal unless by OS/EOS
